## 2000 Years and No Temple

## Leviticus 17:11:

For the soul of the flesh is in the blood and I have assigned it for you upon the Altar to provide atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that atones for the soul.

## Leviticus 5:5:

When one shall become guilty regarding one of these matters, he shall confess what he has sinned. He shall bring as his guilt-offering to HASHEM, for his sin that he committed, a female from the flock -- a sheep or a goat-- for <u>a sin-offering</u> and the Kohen shall provide him atonement for his sin.

## Isaiah 64:4-6:

You have eliminated those who rejoiced in doing righteousness, who would invoke Your ways [in prayer]. You became enrage because we had sinned. We had always [relied] on them and been saved. We have all become defiled and all our righteousness is like a worn-out garment; we all wither like a leaf; and like a wind, our sins carry us off. There is no one to call out in Your Name, who arouses himself to hold fast to You when You hide Your face from us and melt us away because of our iniquities.

From Adam & Eve to Noah is ~2000 years.

From Noah to Mosses commission is  $\sim$  500 years.

From commission to giving of the law ~45 years.

From giving of the law to the destruction of the second temple  $\sim 1500$  years. From the crucifixion of Jesus to today  $\sim 2000$  years.

Sometime after the giving of the law the tabernacle (Exodus 25:9) was built in the desert for the beginning of animal sacrifice. For the next 1500 years HASHEM was teaching the Israelites that blood needed to be shed for the forgiveness of sin.

After HASHEM spent 1500 years on this teaching would you think HASHEM would let man live from 70 CE till today (~2000 years) without any means of forgiveness of sin?

The Talmud's Yoma 39 relates very strange happenings in the Temple beginning in the year 33 CE when Jesus was crucified. HASHEM gave the Jews 37 years to repent and receive their Messiah and as a final sign that Jesus was the Messiah, HASHEM had Rome destroy the Temple in 70 CE.
